Mission

To facilitate free air transportation through volunteer pilots for financially distressed children and adults with medical and humanitarian needs.

Vision

The shortest distance between home and hope.



LifeLine Pilots coordinates private flight for patients (children and adults) who need to travel for medical appointments and treatments using our network of volunteer pilots who donate their time, skills and aircraft to fly them. Additionally, we fly missions for humanitarian needs or flights of compassion.

These flights are free of charge to the patients. All patients must be ambulatory, meaning they must be able to get around on their own and access the plane with little or no assistance sitting upright for the duration of the flight. All adult patients will be allowed to take a companion, and children (18 and under) will be allowed to take both parents or guardians. There are no medical personnel on these flights. Patients are responsible for their transportation to and from the airports.

We serve patients who need to travel in the following states: Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Ohio, Tennessee and Wisconsin. Flights may also extend beyond the states we serve.

Our flights start at 150 nautical miles (flying miles), with a maximum of 750 nautical miles, and may reach beyond the states we serve with the help of additional volunteer pilot organizations.

We do not limit the number of flights a patient may take. Flight availability is dependent on an available volunteer pilot and the weather. Patients are always encouraged to have a backup plan should we not be able to fill a flight or weather conditions will not permit the flight.

Volunteer pilots are always needed! Volunteer pilots must be 21 years of age or older and must have 250 hours of pilot in command time. Volunteer pilots may choose which flights and how many flights they wish to complete. Volunteer pilots are responsible for any fees pertaining to the actual flight. Flight expenses are tax-deductible.
