As our capabilities have grown, our mission has remained the same: to provide training, employment and encouragement that allows individuals with disabilities to achieve financial and social independence. Our motivation is jobs, not profits, which allows us to be responsive and competitive on many different levels.

We serve a population of persons with disabilities from Peoria, Tazewell, Woodford, Fulton and Knox counties.
