Through a wide array of options, individuals with developmental disabilities and visual impairments have many opportunities to fulfill their life goals.

The TCRC Sight Center is the only downstate low vision clinic assisting individuals with low vision issues such as macular degeneration or retinitis pigmentosa. Through low vision rehabilitation specialists, we support each individual patient through a treatment plan that allows them to maximize their independence.

Our educational day services program provides a curriculum-based training program tailored to meet the needs and desires of each individual that we serve. Through daily living skills training, group projects, volunteer opportunities and work-like opportunities, we are supporting each individual to be as independent as they wish to be.
